

## Narrated Presentations

Although PowerPoint automatically comes with the ability to add narration to slides, educators often utilize other programs to reduce the file size, add captions, or ease the process of uploading to an LMS or website. Below is a list of options for the creation of narrated PowerPoints as well as ideas for storing and sharing video files. It is important to think about the ease of use and accessibility of students before creating the videos as choices made in the beginning of the process can open up or limit captioning options. For example, use caution when producing swf files as they are difficult to work with post production and require many more steps to caption.
