Meeting Features

Features or restrictions are only applicable to the license of the meeting **Host, not attendees.**

Meeting Time Limit	40 Minutes	30 Hours
Number of Participants	100	300
Recording	Local only	Cloud or Local recording
Creating/Starting Polls	No	Yes
Streaming Meeting (Youtube etc.)	No	Yes

FAQs

Can I attend meetings longer than 40 minutes? (classes, webinar sessions, office hours etc.) with a basic license?

Yes, users with basic accounts can attend meetings longer than 40 minutes if the host has a pro account.

Can I still collaborate with others outside UCF with a basic license?

Yes, users can still interact and attend collaborative sessions with people outside UCF. The time limit will be restricted to the license of the host.

Can basic licenses holders host meetings?

Yes, meetings can still be hosted for up to 40 minutes. After 40 minutes, the meeting will close.

Can basic license users watch cloud recordings?

Yes, if a pro account holder sends a cloud link, you can still access it to watch. You just cannot record cloud recordings for your own meetings.

Where can I record?

Meetings can be recorded to your local hard drive.

Can I start breakout rooms?

Yes, basic accounts can create up to 50 breakout sessions per meeting.
